Character

Leo, a uniquely thoughtful and sensitive 10-year-old boy; artistic and inquisitive, he's an outcast at school. His often absent mother has made him learn to be independent, but he harbors secret anxieties and repressed anger. Vocal range: Boy soprano, A3-flat – E5.

Description

It's Halloween Eve, 1954, and 10-yr-old Leo is given the unexpected task of caring for an injured pigeon his neighbor found in her yard. As the anxious Leo tries to nurse the bird back to health overnight, he replays the surprising events of day, and we're invited into his complex, emotional world. Longings and resentments are revealed as Leo navigates his relationships with his bullying classmates, his kind neighbor, his distant mother, and the mysterious father he never knew. As he confronts the secrets he harbors and his investment in the pigeon deepens, Leo becomes a changed boy by morning light.
